Early June is the busiest time of the year for our young thespians. Please make time in your schedule to see one (or all!) of our upcoming plays.

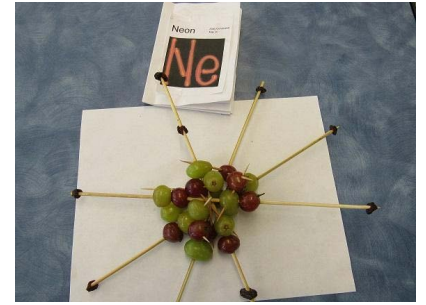

Nurse's Notes

****** NEW IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**** for 2016-**



17. There will be a change to the state immunization requirements throughout the state of Washington. Beginning this fall, all students K-12 are required to show proof of two Varicella (chickenpox) vaccinations. See RCW 28A.210.080 <http://app.leg.wa.gov/RCW/default.aspx?cite=28A.210.080> If you are unsure whether your student has had the required vaccinations, please contact your health care provider and plan to receive needed boosters early. After receiving any vaccination, please submit the date to the school to update your student's vaccination record. The law is unchanged for those who have a signed exemption form on file.

Other recommended vaccinations for preteen and high school students include the HPV vaccination to protect against Human Papilloma Virus and the Meningococcal vaccine to protect against meningitis. All 6th grade students are required to receive a Tdap booster. This vaccination is to protect against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis. There has been a recent rise in pertussis (whooping cough) cases in King County, making this an important booster to receive. If your child is 11 years old and it has been five years or more since their last tetanus-containing vaccine, please call to schedule this vaccination. If other members of your family have not had this vaccination within the past five years, ask your health care provider if they should also receive this vaccination.

When vaccinations are received, please send a copy of the vaccination dates to the school your child currently attends.

If your child is **exempt** from receiving immunizations, state law requires an exemption form to be co-signed by your health care provider for school registration. You may request a copy of this form from your child's school.
